Our aim at Devenish Lodge is to provide a home-like environment for the comfort, safety and wellbeing of each resident.

General Information about the Hostel

- Licensed to accommodate 41 residents: male and female persons aged 18 and over
- Shared/single room (from \$1088/\$1128 per fortnight)
- 24 hour care provided by experienced Licensed Supervisors
- 24 hour access to highly qualified Medical and Psychiatric professionals
- In-house visits from Mental Health Clinical Service, General Practitioner, Podiatrist, Dietician, Pharmacist, Dentist, Mental Health and NDIS Support Recovery Workers

Eligibility criteria

- Adult, aged 18 years and over;
- Diagnosed chronic mental health condition(s);
- receiving Disability Support Pension.

The hostel provides:

- Supervised administration of Webster packed medication
- 3 nutritionally balanced meals – breakfast, lunch and dinner plus morning, afternoon tea and supper
- Large, modern carpeted bedrooms - cleaned daily by contracted professional cleaners
- White melamine bed with 3 drawers and storage space/ innerspring mattress/ sheets, pillow, white cotton blankets, bedcover/ wardrobe with lockable cupboard. Laundry bag
- Towel, flannel, toiletries (soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, disposable shaver, shampoo), underwear and socks, footwear, clothing
- A comfortable lounge room with wall mounted, flat screen LG 79" Ultra HDSmart TV with Foxtel
- Pool table
- Library collection
- Regular group recovery, education and leisurely activities
- Board games, arts and crafts, table tennis, badminton
- Large court yard with shaded areas, grassed enclosed front lawn with porch
- Phone access
- Disability access: ramp, doorway, hallway, dining area, staff office, ground floor bedrooms & disabled toilets with handrails.
- Registered NDIS service – core supports : community access and social participation

plus additional individual staff assistance with:

- Managing finances, tobacco and shopping
- Arrangements for specialist and non-specialist appointments
- Personal hygiene management and education
- Health promotion and education
- Weekly washing, drying and folding of personal laundry
- General activities of daily living assistance
